Self-study basic course on creating accessible content.

Course objective:

- Know various assistive technologies your users may be using.
- Know how accessible technologies utilize the accessibility features you add to your content.
- Determine if an image needs alternative text, and if so, the best alternative text to provide based on the image's purpose.
- Verify if color contrast ratios meet WCAG guidelines.
- Add an appropriate heading structure to your content.
- Know how to format hyperlinks and tables for accessibility.
- Verify the reading order of your content is correct.
- Identify considerations for making content keyboard accessible.
- Generate appropriate closed captions and audio descriptions.
